- 7) Timely cognizance of all the related circulars / Office Orders / Notices related with the scholarships displayed on various platforms by the college including physical copies on the notice boards / WhatsApp Group formed by the college / college's website.
- 8) Timely applications for various certificates, like bonafied certificates, hostel certificate etc., required from the College desk for applying to various scholarships (Government / Non-Government)
- 9) Savings accounts with linked Aadhaar card.
- 10) Regular KYC completion / Updation for the relevant bank accounts
